## Sunday 4 August


### LONDON - SURREY 100

On 4 August, the **Prudential RideLondon-Surrey 100** will see 20,000 amateur cyclists tackle a 100-mile route between the Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park and Surrey. Riders will pass through Tower Hamlets between 06:00 and 08:40.

### LONDON - SURREY CLASSIC

Later that day, 150 of the world's best professional cyclists will compete in the **Prudential RideLondon-Surrey Classic**. The cyclists will pass through the area between 12:45 and 13:05 before following a route similar to the London 2012 Olympic Cycle Road Race.




## Road closure and re-opening times

---

The event route and some surrounding roads in Tower Hamlets will be closed to traffic from 05:00 onwards on 3-4 August. Local access will be maintained for as long as possible, while access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.


All roads will be re-opened as soon as it is safe to do so, although estimated road re-opening times are shown opposite:

## Travel advice during the events



### Road users

You are advised to avoid driving in areas around the routes if at all possible. However, if you intend to drive over the weekend, please plan ahead and allow more time for your journey. Key points to note include:

### 3 August


- Tower Hill, along with roads in the City of London and Westminster, will be closed until the evening

## 4 August

- **The A12 East Cross Route** will be closed early in the morning around the Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park
- **Blackwall Tunnel** will be closed until around 09:00
- **Aspen Way, Limehouse Link** and **The Highway** will be closed until mid-afternoon
- Road and bridge closures will be in place in **central and south-west London** for much of the day
- The **Woolwich Ferry** will be running as normal over the weekend

## Parking

Parking along the route will be suspended on the day. If you usually park on an affected road, you should move your vehicle elsewhere the night before, otherwise it may be removed.


## Public transport

There are no planned rail or London Underground closures in your area on 3-4 August.

Some bus services will need to be diverted, temporarily suspended or terminate earlier than their usual destination as a result of the road closures. Some stops will also be temporarily relocated or suspended.

Please leave more time for bus journeys on the day and plan ahead to understand how your route may be affected. Information will be available nearer the time at affected bus stops and from **[tfl.gov.uk](https://tfl.gov.uk)**

Some Barclays Cycle Hire docking stations will also be suspended over the weekend because of their proximity to the event routes. Visit **[tfl.gov.uk](https://tfl.gov.uk)** for more information.
